HOW TO CLEAN TILES

Keeping your tiles clean is easier than most people think. With the right cleaner and a simple routine, you can keep your floors, showers, and splashbacks looking like new for years.

Tiles themselves are usually quite durable, but grout lines and natural stone surfaces can absorb dirt and stains, which is why proper cleaning products are important.

ROUTINE CLEANING (WEEKLY)

Regular cleaning prevents soap scum, grease, and dirt from building up.

What you'll need

- pH-neutral tile cleaner
- Warm water
- Mop or microfibre cloth

Steps

- Sweep or vacuum the tiles to remove loose dirt.
- Mix the tile cleaner with warm water according to the label instructions.
- Mop or wipe the tiles with the cleaning solution.
- Rinse with clean water if required.
- Allow the floor or surface to dry.

Tip: Using a pH-neutral cleaner is recommended because harsh or acidic cleaners can damage grout or natural stone surfaces.

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REMOVING SOAP SCUM & HARD WATER

Bathrooms and showers often develop soap scum or mineral deposits.

What you'll need

- Heavy Duty Tile and grout cleaner
- Soft scrub pad or sponge

Steps

- Apply the cleaner to the affected area.
- Allow it to sit for a few minutes.
- Gently scrub with a sponge or scrub pad.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- Repeat if necessary for heavy build-up.

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CLEANING GROUT LINES

Grout is porous and can trap dirt.

What you'll need

- Grout cleaner
- Small grout brush

Steps

- Apply cleaner directly onto the grout.
- Allow it to sit briefly.
- Scrub with a grout brush.
- Rinse thoroughly.
- If grout still looks stained after cleaning, a grout colourant or sealer can restore its appearance.

PREVENT FUTURE BUILD-UP

Simple habits can keep tiles cleaner for longer.

- Wipe up spills immediately
- Clean showers weekly to prevent soap scum
- Use pH-neutral cleaners regularly
- Seal grout and natural stone surfaces

Sealing reduces the surface's ability to absorb liquids and stains, giving you more time to clean up spills before staining occurs.

QUICK TILE CARE TIPS

- Use neutral cleaners for regular maintenance
- Avoid acidic cleaners on natural stone
- Clean grout periodically
- Seal porous tiles and grout

With proper care, tile and stone surfaces can stay attractive and easy to maintain for many years.
